We are excited to inform you of the clubs and activities we are offering during the 2019-20 school year. Listed below are the clubs / activities with a brief description of each. We hope that your child will participate in one or more of these clubs / activities to enhance his / her educational experience at Celeste.

Battle of the Books: Open to a team of no more than 10 committed and highly motivated 4th and 5th graders. Each student is required to read 18 books to compete in an all-county competition where students will answer questions in front of a panel of judges. The team meets after school on Mondays and the competition will be held in March 2019. Robotics: Open to a team of seven to ten 4th and 5th graders who are team-oriented individuals with positive attitudes, friendly-competitive spirits, willing to share experiences of research, building, planning, and programming a mechanical device that can perform tasks without human assistance. The club will enthusiastically join science, technology, and teamwork with an awesome dash of fun. Culminating the team's fun is competition with other schools on April 17th at our District Robotics Competition © ! Depending on the amount of interest, try-outs may be performed. This interest information is due Thursday, September 6th. We will meet every Thursday starting Sept. 13th and evaluate with try-outs and cooperative learning games to determine students for the team. Coding Club: We spend time each year in December experimenting with Coding with the Hour of Code and this club will give us more time to try out different forms of Coding (programming). Coding Club consists of approximately 15 students in Grades 3-5. We will meet on the Second and Fourth Mondays of each month starting in October from 2:15-3:30pm in Lab 1. Girls on the Run: At Girls on the Run we inspire girls in grades 3-5 to be joyful, healthy and confident by using fun, experience-based lessons which creatively integrate running. We will practice on Mondays and Thursdays from 2:30-3:45. Transportation is required after each practice. The program will last from September 17 through December 6 . Our final 5 k will be December 9. Girls who are interested in participating will need to register online at www.gotrgreaterpiedmont.org. The registration fee is $\$ 135$ if paid by Sept. 10. The fee will be $\$ 145$ beginning on Sept. 11. Included in this fee are 10 weeks of curriculum based practices with certified coaches, a program t-shirt, registration for the end of season 5 K and a healthy snack at each practice.
